Information Sheet: TOEFL iBT



The internet-based TOEFL Test (iBT)

The Test of English as a Foreign Language™ (TOEFL®) measures the ability of nonnative speakers of English to use and understand English as it is spoken, written, and heard in college and university settings.

The TOEFL internet-based Test (TOEFL iBT) tests all four language skills that are important for effective communication: speaking, listening, reading, and writing. The test helps students demonstrate that they have the English skills needed for study.

Test locations

TOEFL iBT has been introduced to a lot of countries all over the world.

Test locations can be found at the website www.ets.org/toefl/ at the register **Registration/Test Centers**. There are a lot of test locations in several countries and new test locations are added daily. It is recommended to check the website regularly for latest information.

Registration

- Online - The deadline to register online for a test is seven days before the test date. A valid credit card is required.
- By phone - You must call at least seven days before the test date. Valid credit card required. Review the TOEFL iBT Registration Form (PDF) for the information you will be asked to provide when you call. A valid credit card is required. Phone number for applicants from Europe is +31-320-239-540 (European Call Center in Holland, English speaking). Applicants from outside Europe have to look for their [Regional Registration Center](#) (PDF).
- By mail - Registration forms must be received by ETS or your Regional Registration Center at least four weeks before your requested first-choice test date.

Please note, that not all test dates will be available in all locations. Dates are often booked up within a short period. Using internet registration the status will be shown immediately. "No test sites available for this date" may mean "fully booked" as well as "registration not opened by now".

Score report

ETS will send one printed examinee's score record to the examinee and up to four official score reports directly to the institutions or agencies you designate when registering for the test. Score reports will be sent by mail (from U.S.) 15 business days after the test was taken.
